

Brief Biosketch - Jack E. Zigler MD

Dr. Zigler received his Bachelor of Science degree from Cornell University in 1973, and received his MD degree from the Upstate Medical Center in Syracuse, New York in 1977.

Following completion of a residency in Orthopaedic Surgery at The Mount Sinai Hospital in New York City, Dr. Zigler did a 1 year Fellowship in Spine Surgery and Spinal Cord Injury at the Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio, with Dr. Henry Bohlman from 1981 to 1982.

After Fellowship, Dr. Zigler served as Chief of the Spinal Injury Service at Rancho Los Amigos, was a Clinical Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Southern California, and maintained a private practice in Anaheim, California from 1982-1996.

In 1996, Dr. Zigler moved to Dallas to join the Texas Back Institute, where he served as Medical Director. He is a Past-President of the American Spinal Injury Association, Past-President of ISASS, and has served on the Board of the CSRS. He has trained over 125 Spine Fellows.
