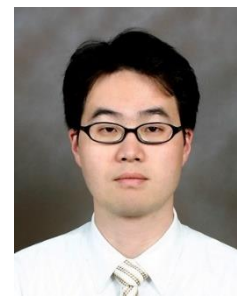

Dr. Jae Hyuk Yang, MD, Ph D. is a professor at Korea University Medical College. He conducts clinical and surgical treatment at Korea University Guro Hospital, specializing in sport spine injury, pediatric and senile spinal deformity and congenital spinal deformity disorders.

Graduating with bachelor's degree of medicine from Korea University Medical College in 2002, he decided to delve deeper into the field of spine surgery. This is why he pursued master's degree of spine specialty and doctor's degrees of spine specialty from his alma mater in 2007 and 2013 respectively.

Based on 85 papers he published in SCI or SICE graded journal of spine field, his research has been recognized as groundbreaking for its ingenuity and importance. He received Best Paper Award (2016) held by the World Congress on Minimally Invasive Spine Surgery and Techniques Association, First Scholarship Award in basic part (2014) held by Korea Orthopedic Association, Best Poster Award (2013) held by Korean-Japanese Combined Orthopaedic Symposium, Russell A. Hibb's Award (2012) held by Scoliosis Research Society, and Best Paper Award (2008) held by Korea Orthopedic Association.

He has been looking for a way to make an impact in spine surgery, by continuously engaging with nationwide community of like-minded scholars. He is a regular member of the Korean Orthopaedic Association, regular member of the Korean Society of Spine Surgery, regular member of the spine deformity research group of the Korean Society of Spine Surgery and associate editor for Journal of the Korean Society of Spine Surgery.
